



A Wrist Support made from Patchwork Fabric

STEP BY STEP 023
Inspiration: 15331

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This wrist support for a keyboard and for the mouse is made from patchwork fabric and filled with plastic pellets.

Print the template which is attached as a PDF file on this page. Cut out the template and tape it together. Arrange the fabric doubled-over, outer side against outer side and place the template on top. Cut out with a 7 mm seam.

Turn inside out and fill with plastic pellets. Sew the hole together very close to the edge either on the sewing machine or by hand.

Sew the two parts together but leave a small opening for the plastic pellets.

Cut a 12 x 12 cm piece of paper for a mouse bag. Place the piece of paper on top of a piece of doubled-over fabric. Cut out with a 7 mm seam. Sew the bag together as described in steps 2 and 3.
