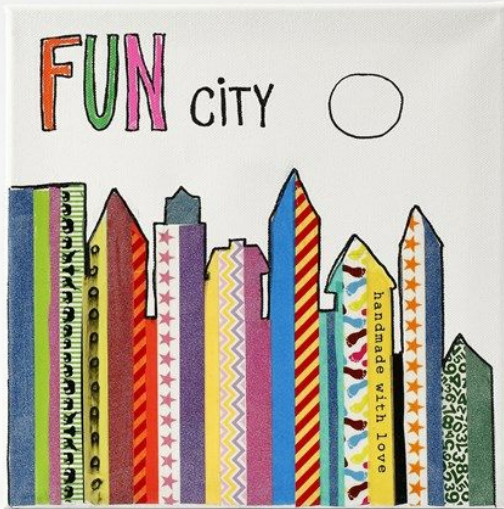


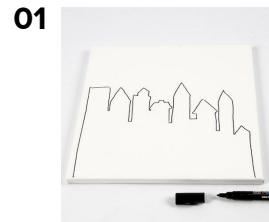
**A Skyline made from Masking Tape on a white Canvas**

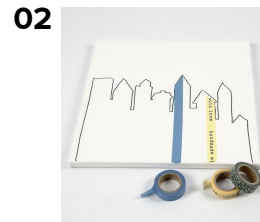


## A Skyline made from Masking Tape on a white Canvas

These skyscraper silhouettes are drawn with a black permanent marker on a white canvas. Masking Tape in different designs and colours is then trimmed and secured inside the outlined skyscrapers.



**01**  
 Draw according to your imagination or print and cut out the template which is available as a separate PDF file for this idea. Outline the design with a black permanent marker, e.g. Uni Posca, on a white canvas. Leave to dry.



**02**  
 Cut pieces of Masking Tape and attach them inside the outlined skyscraper design on the canvas according to your taste.



**03**  
 Apply a coat of A-color allround medium glue lacquer ensuring that the Masking Tape does not come unstuck on the canvas. Leave to dry.
