



A short Poncho with a Roll Neck

This is lovely to knit – and lovely to wear. Knit two elongated pieces, sew them together and knit a roll neck onto the poncho. We have used a No. 10 Circular Knitting Needle.

Materials

Materials □ 8 balls of Sydney Yarn.
 □ No. 10 Circular Knitting Needle.

A Poncho

Poncho: □ Cast on 30 stitches very loosely. From here knit according to the pattern all the way around. □ 1st row: plain stitches □ 2nd row: 2 plain stitches, *2 plain stitches together, yarn over*. Repeat from * to * until you have 2 stitches left. Knit these as plain stitches.
 □ 3rd row: plain stitches. □ 4th row: 2 plain stitches, *yarn over, 2 plain stitches together*. Repeat from * to * until you have 2 stitches left. Knit these as plain stitches. □ Repeat these four rows until the knitted piece measures 65cm. Then knit one row plain stitches. □ Cast off very loosely on the next row. □ Knit another piece like this. Sew the two

Roll Neck

Pick up 52 stitches around the neck with the Circular Knitting Needle and knit ribbed knitting (2 plain stitches, 2 purl) until the roll neck measures 35cm. Cast off loosely and secure all the ends.
