

A Baby blanket

Cast 162 stitches onto No. 5 circular knitting needles

Knit 3 rows of plain knitting

Now knit the first 3 stitches plain, knit 12 stitches plain, then 12 stitches purl. Continue like this until there are 3 stitches left. Knit the last 3 stitches plain.

Knit 12 rows like this

After 12 rows, knit the first 3 stitches plain, then knit 12 stitches purl and 12 stitches plain etc.

Change the pattern again after 12 rows

Continue until the blanket is the desired length and finish with 3 rows of plain knitting

Decorate the blanket with a crocheted border; 5 basic treble stitches in every 3 stitches

Yarn required for approx. 1 square meter:

14 balls of Melbourne Yarn
