

# A crocheted soap pouch from natural twine

Crochet a soap pouch from natural twine made from coarse flax which scrubs the body comfortably in the shower. Keep your bar of soap in the pouch and hang the pouch to dry in between showers by the crocheted strap added at the end.

- 1: Chain 11 ch using UK size 5 crochet hook.
- 2: Crochet 2 dc in the 2nd chain from the hook, 1 dc in each of the next 8 stitches and 2 dc in the last stitch.
- 3: Continue crocheting on the opposite of the chain band.
- 4: Now crochet round the entire row as follows:
- 5: Begin with 1 tr, then 2 tr in the next stitch, 1 tr in each of the next 8 stitches, 2 tr in the next stitch, 1 tr in each of the next 2 stitches, 2 tr in the next stitch, 1 tr in each of the next 8 stitches, 2 tr in the next stitch. Finish with a tr.
- 6: Crochet 10 rows of tr. Finish by pulling the strand through the loop and weaving in the ends.
- 7: Crochet ch until you have a cord measuring approx. 60 cm. Insert this in the 3rd ch row from the top. Insert this in the 3rd ch row from the top.

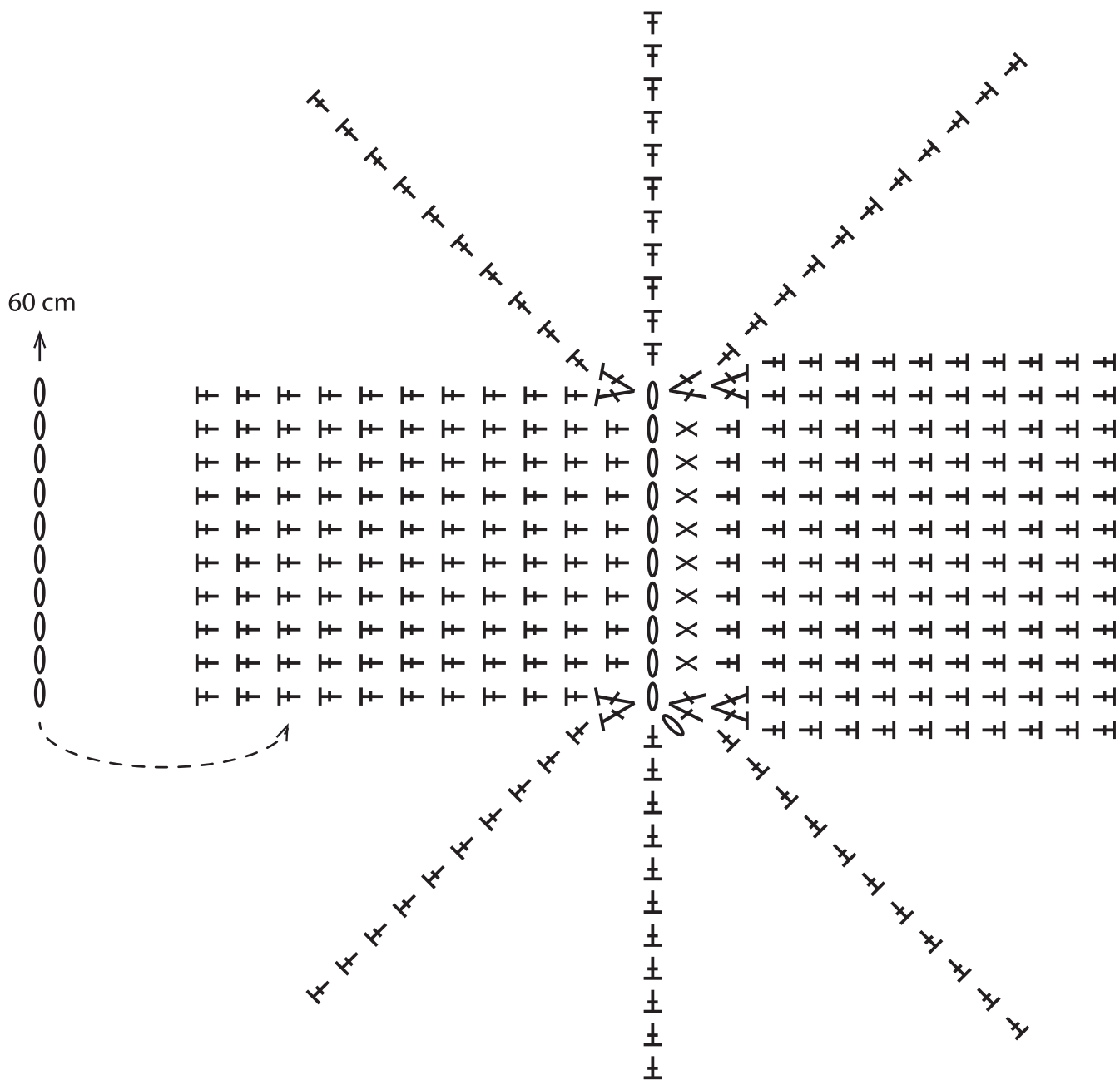
