# Knitted and felted Baubles 

No. 4 knitting needles
Melbourne woolen yarn

## Knitting pattern

Polystyrene ball, measuring 5 cm in diameter: Cast 28 stitches onto a No. 4 kntting needle and knit 20 rows of plain knitting.
Polystyrene ball, measuring 7 cm in diameter: Cast 40 stitches onto a No. 4 knitting needle and knit 30 rows of plain knitting.

A knitting pattern for a star is attached as a template. This pattern may be knitted twice when knitting for the polystyrene ball measuring 7 cm in diameter.
Sew the short ends of the square together, forming a tube.

Tack a piece of wool at the top and at the bottom of the knitted tube. Put the ball inside the tube. Tighten the pieces of wool and tie a knot. To make a string for hanging, crochet 40 chain stitches and sew this onto the bauble.

Wash in the washing machine at $40^{\circ}$, on a normal programme without pre-wash, and with detergent without enzymes or bleach.
For the baubles to shrink further, wash again or dry in the dryer.
