

Socks knitted in a spiral pattern

One size for adults / one size for children

Yarn requirement for one pair of socks: 2 balls of sock yarn

Cast on 60 stitches / 40 stitches on No. 3 double pointed sock knitting needles – distribute the stitches on 3 or 4 knitting needles.

Knit the pattern * K3, P2 *. Repeat from * to * for 4 rounds.

Shift the pattern on the 5th round by 1 stitch and knit * K2, P2, K1 * !

Shift the pattern on the 9th round by 1 stitch and knit * K1, P2, K2 * !

Shift the pattern on the 13th round by 1 stitch and knit * P2, K3 * !

Shift the pattern on the 17th round by 1 stitch and knit * P1, K3, P1 * !

Repeat from * to * for 4 rounds.

Continue the pattern in the same manner from the beginning until the desired length is reached. Finish with K3, P2 rounds.

Decreasing for the toe:

Knit * K1, K2 tog, P2 * in the 1st round.

Knit * K2, P2 * in the 2nd round.

Knit * K2, P2 tog * in the 3rd round.

Knit * K2, P1 * in the 4th round.

Knit * K2 tog, P1 * in the 5th round.

Knit * K1, P1 * in the 6th round.

Knit all the stitches K2 tog in the 7th round.

Repeat from * to *.

Break the yarn and pull the end of the yarn through the remaining stitches and secure it.

If the adult sock measures 55 cm (children 45 cm) prior to decreasing for the toe, it will be a medium size in use.

Abbreviations and symbols explanation:

cs = crochet stitch

r = knit one

vr

together

*

= purl one

= tog

= repeat from * to *
