Yarn requirements per placement
160 g ribbon and 20 g cotton yarn

Crochet hook no. 10.

Abbreviations and symbol explanations

- ch = chain stitch
- htr = half treble crochet
- dc = double crochet
- * = repeat from * to * for the whole the round

Crochet with 1 thread (rows 1-5 ribbon)

1. Crochet 20 ch, turn with 2 ch Technique 1
2. *Crochet 20 htr, turn with 2 ch Technique 2
3. Crochet 20 dc, turn with 2 ch* Technique 3
4. Repeat * to *
5. Crochet, 20 htr, turn with 2 ch

Crochet with 2 threads

(rows 6-12, ribbon and cotton yarn.)

- ~~6. Crochet 20 dc with 2 threads (turn with 2 ch)~~
7. Crochet 20 htr, turn with 2 ch
8. Repeat row 6
9. Repeat row 7
10. Repeat row 6
11. Repeat row 7
12. Crochet 20 dc, turn with 2 ch

Crochet with 1 thread (ribbon, rows 13-18)

13. Repeat rows 2 and 3 for a total of 3 times (6 rows)

Crochet with 2 threads:

(ribbon and cotton yarn. Rows 19-24)

14. Repeat rows 6 and 7 with 2 threads a total of 3 times. (6 rows)
15. Close and fasten off the ends.

Tip: Iron/steam into shape under a moist tea towel. 30 cm x 37 cm
